

## **Early EHCP Reviews**

## When can I ask for an early review of my child's EHCP?

At any time, as long as you have a good reason. This review is carried out by the LA but the evidence gathering review meeting may be delegated to the school/college by the LA. If there is health care provision in the EHC Plan, the health service provider who is arranging the provision will be invited as well.

## What would be a good reason for asking for an early review?

You should ask for an early statutory review if you believe:

- that your child/young person's education, health or social care needs have changed and are no longer accurately described in the EHC plan; or
- that the education, health or social care provision in the EHC plan is no longer meeting your child/ young person's needs. This includes if you feel that section I (the placement) needs to be reviewed.

## Should I speak to the school/college first?

Yes. Speak to your child's class/ subject teacher and the Head teacher/ Principal of the College about your worries, as well as contacting the LA.
